Sydney, Australia
Inhabitants: 4 840 600
Museums : 30
Time to visit the zoo : 2 hours
Time to build the Opera House : 16 years

- a) Question: How many inhabitants are there in Sydney? Answer: There are 4 840 600 (inhabitants)*.
- b) Question: How many museums are there in Sydney? Answer: There are 30 (museums)*.
- c) Question: How much time do I need to visit the zoo? Answer: You need 2 hours.
- d) Question: How much time did it take to build the Opera House? Answer: It took 16 years instead of 10.

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
